Straight From the Lyon's Mouth

The following text is from the Arlington County Police Department bicycle registration information sheet:

Protect Your Bicycle From Theft

1. **Keep a record of your bicycle serial number**, which is usually located on the bottom of the frame, between the pedals.
2. **If your bicycle does not have a serial number**, mark your bicycle where your serial number would be by engraving your initials or a four-digit number of your choice.
3. **Register your bicycle**, at no cost, with the Arlington County Police Department, or register on the Web.
4. Go to **www.arlingtonva.us** and click on **Bicycle Registration**

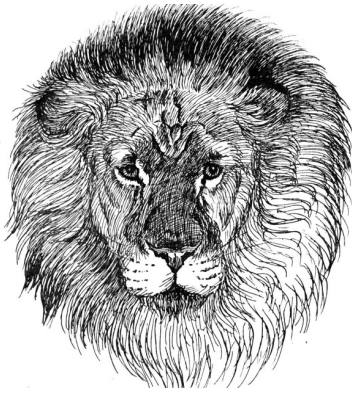
